

ADULT CLASSES

Drop-in class:	\$19/class
5-class card:	\$ 90
10-class card:	\$175

NOTE: Children's Classes:

- **Registration Fee:** \$65
- **Discounts:** There is a 5% discount, if tuition is paid in full by September 1, 2026. This discount applies to regular registration/tuition. This does apply for VIP or Tuition Freeze accounts.
- **Payment Plans:** For the Pre-professional Track or a full season Enrichment class may be made in 8-installments (September through April) for the September 2026 to May 2027 season, unless a 9-installment plan is selected and begins in August 1, 2026. Each of the eight payments is due on or before the 1st of the month from September 1, 2026 through April 1, 2027. **The account holder must pay the first month's tuition manually. A payment plan does not begin until the second month that the student is enrolled.**
- **9-month Plans:** In the event, that the student is in the Pre-Professional Upper and Lower Division and takes 5+ classes which include multi-day classes, there is an option to pay tuition in 9- installments beginning on August 1, 2026 only (and concluding on April 1st, 2027).
- **Sampler Classes:** Tuition for Sampler Classes is due at registration.
- **Payment Methods:** Payments may be made via credit card, ACH, bank/cashier's check, or money order.
- **Auto Pay:** All dancers must be enrolled in autopay. Tuition payments for children's classes must be made by credit card directly on MSDC's dance studio software (Studio Pro) or via ACH payment. If you elect to pay by credit card or ACH, there may be a convenience fee levied by the processor. If a credit card charge fails or an ACH payment is declined, the dancer's account will be suspended and the dancer will be ineligible to take class, until the account is rectified.
- **Late Fees:** A late fee in the amount of \$40 will also be applied to the account five days after the due date, if the account is not paid on time or if a credit card payment is rejected and the account is removed from autopay. The late fee will need to be reconciled before the account can be re-activated and the student allowed to resume classes. There are no make ups for classes missed.
- **Costumes:** for students in the Pre-professional track will not be distributed to any student with an outstanding balance.
- **Delinquent Accounts:** After 5 days, a delinquent account will be assessed a late fee of \$40 and the dancer will not be allowed to take class. Unfortunately, there are NO exceptions. In the case of an outstanding balance after April 1st, 2027, a \$50 late fee will be assessed each month. Delinquent accounts are subject to lawsuit and/or collections.
